
Your stunt number for the competition is determined by the order in which they are received, so the sooner you get it in the lower your order number will be!!!

The competition this year will be held at the Aladdin Shrine on Friday morning, April 17, 2020. Remember that stunt competition is one of the major focuses of our convention. So please give this endeavor your full support.

If you need to ship your stunt(s) the address is on the Stunt Information Sheet for the Aladdin Shrine. You will also be responsible for having your stunts shipped back home. Please ship for a Wednesday arrival.

ATTENTION ALL DIRECTORS

Stunts presented in SDA Competition are judged according to the following criteria:

1. Originality
2. Safety and construction
3. Presentation
4. Audience acceptance
5. Practicality

In addition, the following SDA Stunt Regulations must be complied with:

1. No activity prohibited by the law of the land.
2. No unsafe or dangerous stunts.
3. No flame, fire, gunpowder, or any other such material or substance may be used in the stunts.
4. No electricity. Pain and trauma are not acceptable.
5. No stunts may be used in which animals or individuals portray excretions from the body, actual or simulated.
6. Stunts emanating from toilets, outhouses, etc., are absolutely taboo and prohibited, whether in a ceremonial or on the street.
7. Stunts in which animals are subjected to electricity are prohibited.
8. Breakout stunts should not be constructed of wood frame work, nails, wire, etc., or any material which might injure the candidate or novice.
9. Stunts which would demean the candidate or novice are not acceptable.
10. Disclaimers, consent forms, and waivers are not acceptable.

Use of cameras will be permitted at the Preview of Stunts Session only.

Wet, messy stunts are acceptable.

Back-fire stunts are acceptable.
